

## Who is Jesus?

Lets take some time to look at the clear description we get of Jesus from prophecy and how it was fulfilled in scripture.

Eternal – He existed before time began.	Micah 5:2 & Col 1:15-17

Born of a virgin.	Isaiah 7:14 & Luke 1:26
Born in Bethlehem	Micah 5:2 & Matt. 2:5
Descendent of David – Born a King	Isaiah 9:6-7 & Matt. 1:1-17
Accompanied by signs, wonders, miracles	Isaiah 35:4-6; 60:22 & Luke 7:20-22
Lived a sinless life	Isaiah 53:8-9 & 1 Peter 2:21-22; Heb. 4:15
Became an offering for our sins	Isaiah 53:10-11 & Romans 5:7-9
Death on a cross	Deut. 21:23 & Gal. 3:13
Thirsty on the cross	Psalm 22:5 & John 19:28
Struck on the head	Micah 5:1 & Matt. 27:30
Hands and feet pierced	Psalm 22:6, Zech 12:10 & John 20:25-29
Soldiers cast lots for his clothes	Psalm 22:18 & John 19:23-24
Given sour wine to drink	Psalm 69:20-22 & Matthew 27:34
Beaten and spat upon	Isaiah 50:5 & Matthew 26:26-30, 67
Betrayed by a friend	Psalm 41:9, 55:12-14 & Matt. 26:14-16
Commit his spirit into God's hand	Psalm 31:5 & Luke 23:46

This is just a small sample of the hundreds of prophecies from the bible that were fulfilled by the person of Jesus Christ. They give us clarity to understand who Jesus is from eternity past, and what He did while He was on earth.
