Considering the Commands - James 4:7-10

We could approach these verses in various ways:

- #1 Consider the commands as ten separate imperatives.
- #2 Survey the commands from the priest-prophet perspective.
- #3 View the first and last commands as bookends. If so ...
 - ✓ The first and last commands introduce & summarize that grace is received thru humility.
 - ✓ The rest of the commands divide into three couplets that further explain the theme.

FIRST COMMAND: RELINQUISH CONTROL OF YOUR LIFE. 4:7a "Therefore submit to God."

The word **submit** means to "take rank under." The proud person will find this to be a challenge. He will want to do things his way.

LAST COMMAND: RESPOND HUMBLY TO SUCCESS. 4:10 "Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and He will lift you up."

This concept occurs more than fifty times in the Word of God. The way you find the blessing of God is through humility. Humility is not thinking less of yourself; it is thinking of yourself less – and thinking of God more.
